# RESOLUTIONS/ACTIONS FROM WIND LOADING GROUP, APEC-WW 20 November 2007

## 1. Example building calculations (Priority 1)

- (a) Correction of known errors in examples 1, 2 and 3 by 31-1-08 (transmitted to PK, YT and JDH).
- (b). Checking of all calculations from each economy by at least one independent person by 31-1-08 (transmitted to PK, YT and JDH).
- (c). Final comparisons should be posted on APEC-WW web site linked to www.iawe.org by 31-3-08.
- (d). Further comparisons with relaxing of constraints (fix wind speed at 10 metres in open terrain not at building top; fix dynamic properties with comments) by **31-12-08**?
- (e). Publishing of comparisons with comments and discussion in one paper at AWAS 08 (current specifications) (31-3-08) & one paper at APCWE -09 (28-2-09) (relaxed constraints) and later a journal (31-12-09).

# 2. Harmonization of codes/standards (Priority 2)

- (a) Standardization of terrains / profiles **Nov 2009** (APCWE) EC, with JCCC, YT, C-M.C, PAI ?
- (b) APEC model code/ ISO suitability. PK will convene with ABK, R.B, RA, YT nominee, Nasly report by **Nov. 2009** on web site
- (c) Cross-economy design wind speed boundaries. M-Th; K-C; HK-C (Nov 2008)
- (d) Table of Return period/load factors JDH, RB, KK nominee, ABK, PAI ? (November 2008)

## 3. Regional cooperation (Priority 3)

- (a). Unrepresented economies : <u>Bangladesh</u>, <u>Macau</u>, South Pacific (<u>Fiji</u>) , <u>Sri</u> <u>Lanka</u> , Cambodia, Laos, Nepal communicate representation via apec-ww web site (all-**November 2009**)
- (b). Economies in AP regions without WE associations affiliated with IAWE could combine as one or more associations (APCWE **November 2009**)

#### 4. Other future activities

- (a). Collect windstorm damage statistics (economic loss). Assessment methods and data management to be presented at next APEC-WW (Nov 2009)(Priority 2).
- (b). 2009 APEC-WW to follow APCWE in Taipei (**November 12-13, 2009**) (**Priority 1**).
